WHAT IS VERIFICATION

Your application was selected for review in a process called Verification. Los Angeles Harbor College (LAHC) will compare the information on your application with the information reported on the signed copies of your and your parent's (if applicable), 2006 Federal tax forms including W-2 forms or other financial documents. Federal law (34 CFR, Part 688) states that LAHC has the right to ask your income and asset information before federal aid can be awarded to you. If there are discrepancies between the information on your application and financial documents, LAHC may have to correct the information on your application.
